

# Cookies

## About the use of cookies

### What is a cookie?

A cookie is a file, generally small and identified by a name, placed in your browser by a website that you visit. Your browser will store the cookie until the end of its validity or retention period and will send it back to the web server every time that you visit the website. Cookies allow us to collect information about your browsing and provide services appropriate to your device (PC, mobile or tablet). We do not use cookies capable of identifying you personally.

In order to optimize the performance, functionality and interactivity of our website, we use the categories of cookies described in the following paragraph.

### What types of cookies are used by VINCI Energies group websites?

#### 1. Technical Cookies

We inform you about the use of technical cookies that allow the website's main services to work optimally. They are required to use the website and its various products and services.

Depending on your browser's settings, you can block these cookies. However, blocking them may adversely affect your experience on the website.

GDPR Cookie Consent: viewed_cookie_policy	Used by the "GDPR Cookie Consent" module, this cookie is used to store whether or not the user has	6 months

cli_user_preference	Stores the user's cookie consent status.	6 months
pll_language	Management of the website's multilingual features	12 months
TS01#	Cookie that allows load balancing to function. This cookie is placed in your browser when you connect to the website.	Session
wp-settings-#	WordPress uses this cookie to personalise your view of the administration interface and possibly also the website's main interface.	12 months

## 2. Analytics Cookies

These cookies aim to measure the audience of our website's content and sections in order to assess them and organise them better. They also allow us to detect browsing problems and therefore make our services more user-friendly.

Depending on your browser's settings, you can block these cookies. However, blocking them may adversely affect your experience on the website.

The lifetime of these cookies does not exceed 13 months.

**Matomo.** We use Matomo audience measurement cookies, the sole purposes of which are those listed above, for our sole benefit.

These cookies only produce anonymous statistics and website traffic figures, and do not produce any individual information.

**Google Analytics.** We request your **consent** before using, in addition, Google Analytics audience measurement cookies. By default, refusal is assumed and these cookies are not placed in your browser nor activated.

As well as the purposes for our benefit listed above, the browsing data collected may be used by Google Analytics on its own account to offer targeted advertisements and content based on your browsing history. The purposes and conditions of that use are described in greater detail [here](#).

## Your choices regarding the management of cookies

Your browser can also be set to accept or block cookies.

### 1. Rejecting a cookie via your browser

You can deactivate all or some cookies at any time. Your browser may also be set to notify you of cookies sent and ask you whether you accept them (on a case-by-case or global basis). Please note, however, that deactivating all cookies will prevent you from using our site in normal conditions, beyond the basic functions.

Each browser's configuration is different for managing cookies and your preferences. It is described in the help menu of the browser, which will explain how to change the settings for cookies. For:
